Using the Roller Striker/Screed

Make sure you understand who will be giving instructions and what the signals will be.

Lift the roller into place at the start of the bay. Start the roller rotating, and walk steadily

The third member of the team should be ready to shovel concrete, as necessary, ahead

of the roller to achieve a rough level. You should have a small "wave" of concrete

If you need to go back over an area, let the screed roll back up the bay a short way.

When you are walking backwards, keep a check for obstacles you might trip over or

Watch out for signs that vibration may be affecting your hands. If your fingers start to

tingle or feel numb, take a short break from using the machine. Exercise your fingers to

To help prevent vibration affecting your hands, operate the machine for shorter

periods, or share the job with workmates. Keep your hands warm - wearing gloves

Take care not to bend the flexible drive hose through tight angles, for example over

You must clean the screed as soon as you have finished work, before any concrete

15. If you disengage the drive hose, take care to keep the open end of it clean - do not

10. Always move the roller steadily - this will help create a hard and level surface.

11. Do not touch the rotating part of the roller while it is in operation.

12. Do not disengage the drive hose while the engine is running.

13. Stop the engine if leaving the machine unattended.
