Using the Wallpaper Stripper

Each section of wallpaper treated will be very hot. Take care while handling it.

Switch off and remove the plug then allow the equipment to cool down completely

Always place the boiler unit on a heat resistant drip tray and not on a decorative surface. Make sure the steam plate is placed on a heat resistant drip tray when not

The part that stays hot longest is the filler cap. Allow it to cool then remove it
